English: We sequenced the main events in Handa's Surprise and then retold the story orally by adding detail of our own. We then wrote about Handa's journey back to her village by using key features of the original text.

Maths: We partitioned numbers to 100 in different ways and practised writing numbers to 100 in numerals and words.

Geography: We looked at the weather across all four nations in the United Kingdom this week. We also looked at seasonal changes in weather over the year in the UK.

Science: We walked around the school grounds to see if we could spot any pigeons, but we didn't have any luck! Whilst we were out, we also looked for things that are living, dead and never been alive. Back in class, we sorted and classified pictures using these same criteria.
