This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We began the week by learning how apostrophes can be used in contracted words and played a game to match the contractions with the corresponding expanded words. We used drama to explore events that took place in *The Way Back Home* and then wrote our own version of the journey into space using the past tense.

Maths: Through collaborative learning, we subtracted a single digit number from a tens number using a number line. We noticed how knowing our number bonds could help us to be more efficient when checking if our calculations were correct. Later in the week, we used number lines to bridge across a tens number. We have also used Base 10 resources to exchange a ten for 10 ones when subtracting.

RE: We learnt about the festival of Hanukkah and the importance of light in the story.

D.T: We have been testing out the skills we need for making a sensational salad. We learnt how to safely use a grater, peeler and knife.
