This week in Kingfisher Class...

What a busy week it has been! The children have worked hard to learn their spellings for Wednesday's Spelling Bee and each and every child had a go, tried their best and impressed us. Well done everyone!

Today, we had a visit from BrightBites Dental Programme. The children took part in a workshop to learn about the importance of good oral hygiene, eating healthily and avoiding sugary foods and drink.

English: We applied what we know about writing sentences in our D.T work. We wrote accurate sentences to say what we have learnt when preparing vegetables.

Maths: We have been adding and subtracting multiples of 10, noticing the patterns that we make when using a 100 square to solve calculations, e.g. $36 - 20 = ?$

We have also used Base to add 2 two-digit numbers and practised exchanging ten ones for 1 ten.

D.T: So far, we have tasted some salad items and learnt how to peel, grate and cut. This week, we have designed what our Sensational Salads would look like on a menu. On Monday, we will be making our salads!

PSHRE: We are learning about Bullying and focusing on online bullying. We have discussed what is sometimes an accident and what is done on purpose.
