English: We have continued to look at *Journey* by Aaron Becker and have developed our own interpretation of the story through discussion and drama.

Maths: [Placing Numbers on a Number Line - Tablet Version - Mathsframe](#): You might find this online game useful as it supports the work that we have been doing in class this week. It will help the children understand where numbers go on a number line. This week, we have also compared objects using the greater than, less than and equal symbols.

Science: We discussed the habitat that an Oak Tree provides for many different species. Unfortunately, the bad weather meant that we could not make any first-hand observations. This may be something that you wish to do at home.

History: We looked at different explorers from the past and placed them on a timeline. We then found out who Ibn Battuta and George Vancouver were, why they were important historical figures and places they explored.
