English: We used drama to explore characters' thoughts and feelings and used expanded noun phrases to describe imaginary settings. As part of our learning in SPAG, we have looked at the difference between commands, questions, exclamations and statements, and noted the punctuation needed when writing each sentence type.

Maths: We have practised writing numbers to 100 in expanded form and placed 10's and 1's on a number line to 100.

Science: We talked about how animals are suited to their habitats by doing a study of penguins. We noticed the ways in which some of the species are more suited to their specific environment.

PSHRE: We looked at what we can do if a friendship is making us feel unhappy. We created out own 'Helpful Hands' and listed people we could turn to if we needed help.
