## This week in Kingfisher Class...

**English:** We read Handa's Surprise and noticed the common and proper nouns in selected pages. We then completed a challenge to correct proper nouns by adding capital letters. Later on in the week, we wrote expanded noun phrases. We have also practised changing the tense from the present to the past.

**Maths:** We have been reading numbers to 100 by noticing the 10's and 1's and using a place value chart to order numbers and explain the value of each digit.

**Geography:** We have labelled the continents and oceans on a world map and the countries and surrounding seas on a map of the United Kingdom.

**PSHRE:** We have discussed the importance of having good manners and completed a paired activity where teamwork and good manners were essential.

**Science:** We have started our new topic thinking about Living Things and their Habitats. We talked about a pigeon as a starting point for this topic.

**Computing:** This week, we have started to recognise what I.T means and have identified some items which are classed as Information Technology.
